A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN
AS APPROVED BY THE SCHUYLKILL COUNTY BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS ON MARCH 9, 2011

WHEREAS the Borough of Port Carbon is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the Commonwealth Borough Code, 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 45101, et seq; and


WHEREAS the Borough of Port Carbon is responsible to take action to protect the lives and property of the citizens in the event of a natural or human-caused emergency or disaster, including terrorism; and

WHEREAS the Borough of Port Carbon must satisfy the requirements of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 Pa. C.S. Section 7101 et seq., as amended) to have a disaster emergency management plan for the municipality which consists of a Basic Plan which describes principles and doctrine, a Notification and Resource Manual, which provides listings and means of contacting local and needed resources; and a series of functional checklists which provide detail for the accomplishment of the specifics of the operation. The scope of the Plan includes all activities in the entire emergency management cycle, including prevention, preparedness, response and recovery phases. The plan is applicable to all response organizations acting for or on behalf of the government or citizens of municipalities in Schuylkill County.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved the Borough of Port Carbon adopts the Schuylkill County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) dated March 2011.


