

RESOLUTION # 2011-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE FEE STRUCTURE FOR SEWAGE ENFORCEMENT WORK AND SEWAGE PERMITS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council enacted Ordinance _____ permitting on-site sewage disposal systems for residential property whereby a dwelling home is situate 150 feet or more from the closest sewage main of Greater Pottsville Area Sewer Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, the Borough Council of PORT CARBON, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania, hereby resolves that the following fees for service indicated are hereby established and are to remain in full force and effect until such time as the Borough, by subsequent resolution, may adopt a new or additional schedule of fees and costs.

1. **Site Testing**

Site Investigation & Soil Probe Analysis (Includes 2 probes per existing or proposed lot)	\$150.00
Additional Probes	\$60.00/Probe
Percolation (Perc) Testing (Assumes 2 test of six (6) holes each @ same time)	\$360.00
Additional Perc Tests (per set of six (6) holes)	\$180.00/Perc

Additional Interim Inspection	\$ 60.00
Call back for final inspection (if Final Inspection not approved)	\$120.00

(Does not include repair or replacement of absorption area) | \$120.00 |
| 12. | All Commercial, Business, Multi-Family Units and Subdivisions shall be billed a fee of \$60.00/Hr. | |
| 13. | All work not covered in the above will be billed at a fee of \$60.00/Hr. | |
| 14. | Application for any system must include a completed PADEP application. A minimum check of \$150.00 must accompany all initial applications. Payment of fees shall be made by Certified Check, Money Order or equivalent and shall be collected by the Sewage Enforcement Officer payable onto THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON. | |
| 15. | Please note that the above fees do not include the digging of the 7' soil probe pit, the individual percolation test holes or initial pre-soak (8 to 24 hours prior to testing). The percolation test site must be accessible by two-wheel drive vehicle to within fifty feet. The applicant must provide a back-hoe and operator for digging of the probe pit and must also dig the percolation test holes. The applicant must provide a minimum of 50 gallons of water at each percolation test site. | |
| 16. | If the applicant requests, perc test holes may be dug by the SEO for a cost rate of \$120 per six test holes. The availability of the SEO will dictate if the SEO is able to dig the holes, otherwise the applicant is required to dig the perc holes as defined in Note 15. | |
| 17. | Mileage: Mileage may be charged at a rate permitted by PADEP. Mileage costs for non-planning work items (i.e. permit, inspections, malfunctions, complaints, etc) are eligible for reimbursement from DEP. | |
| 18. | Fees must be paid in full prior to release of permits/test results. | |
| 19. | The Borough shall possess authority for the withholding the release and issuance of | |

permits/test results of any applicant should applicant be delinquent in real estate taxes, sanitation, charges, or any other municipal charges.
