**RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON RESTRICTING TRAFFIC ON  
THE WASHINGTON STREET BRIDGE**

**Whereas**, the Borough of Port Carbon is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the Commonwealth Borough Code, 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 45101, et seq; and

**Whereas**, the Borough of Port Carbon is currently impacted by a traffic detour as a result of construction on the Pottsville Street Bridge;

**Whereas**, there is concern for the safety of residents in light of the increased traffic and potential for danger with traffic exiting Washington Street onto Pike Street;


**Whereas**, in an effort to reduce risk during construction, a traffic light was erected at the intersection of Jackson and Coal Streets;

**Whereas**, there is concern in the event of a traffic backlog, the response of the Good Will Fire Co # 2 may be impacted, causing delay in the response to an emergency call;


**Whereas**, in order to assure travelers travel the established detour route, it is necessary to limit traffic travelling over the Washington Street Bridge to local traffic only;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved and enacted traffic over the Washington Street Bridge is limited to local traffic only for the next ninety (90) days, subject to extension as ordered by the Mayor.


