A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ADDRESSING PASSENGERS ACCOMPANYING POLICE OFFICERS WHILE ON PATROL.
Whereas, the Borough of Port Carbon is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the Commonwealth Borough Code, 53 Pa.C.S.A. § 45101, et seq: and
Whereas, the Council of the Borough of Port Carbon recognizes the need to assure for the safety of its citizens and police officers;
Whereas, the Council of the Borough of Port Carbon recognizes the need for police investigations to be confidential;
Whereas, the Council of the Borough of Port Carbon recognizes non-law enforcement passengers in the police vehicle while police are on patrol may violate confidentiality and place additional risk to the occupants of the vehicle;
Whereas , the Council of the Borough of Port Carbon recognizes non-law enforcement passengers in the police vehicle while police are on patrol may impede and investigation / arrest or impact the integrity of an investigation / arrest;
Whereas, the Council of the Borough of Port Carbon recognizes the need for non-law enforcement persons to ride as a passenger in a police vehicle during parade and special events;
NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved and enacted this 4 th day of August, 2015, non-law
enforcement persons are prohibited from accompanying police while police are on patrol.
Passengers are permitted to ride in the police vehicle with police during parades and special
events with prior formal authorization of Borough Council. It is understood that in the event of
an emergency call during such times, the passenger would be removed from the vehicle prior to
