A RESOLUTION SETTING FEES FOR ENFORCEMENT OF CHAPTER 189 OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON CODE OF ORDINANCES AS PERMITTED BY ORDINANCE AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Port Carbon is a municipal corporation organized and operating under the Commonwealth Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, Borough of Port Carbon Borough Council convened for a regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, December 21, 2021, and enacted an amendment to Chapter 189 of the Port Carbon Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance granted authority onto Borough Council of Borough of Port Carbon to set fees for enforcement of the newly amended Chapter 189 of the Borough of Port Carbon Code of Ordinances, and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance Amendment granted authority onto Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon to establish zoning districts for effective ordinance enforcement.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, and it is resolved as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though set forth hereto.
2. Fees for enforcement of Chapter 189 are as follows:
 - a) Inspector shall be compensated at the amount of \$80.00 for the initial rental unit, and \$50.00 for every additional unit to be inspected within the premises per inspection visit.
 - b) Program Administration for Chapter 189 shall be billed in the sum of \$80.00 per hour.
 - c) Enforcement of Administration for Chapter 189 shall be billed at \$80.00 per hour.
 - d) Miscellaneous activities resulting from chapter 189 shall be billed at \$80.00 per hour.
 - e) Borough of Port Carbon may bill reasonable and customary fees for administrative work and costs such as printing, mailing, receiving registration forms and deposit of fees.

f) The Code Enforcement Officer and Council Member chairing code enforcement committee shall develop zoning districts, and keep same on file for staggered inspection and administration under Chapter 189.


3. In the event any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Resolution shall be deemed to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provision, section sentence clause or part of this Resolution, it being the intent of the Borough that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

4. All resolutions heretofore or parts of resolutions heretofore adopted by the Borough, inconsistent herewith are expressly repealed.

5. All resolutions previously adopted by the Borough not in conflict herewith shall remain full force and effect and read in pari materia.




