

## Chapter 174

### PEDDLING AND SOLICITING

**[HISTORY: Adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon 6-3-1952 by Ord. No. 148. Amendments noted where applicable.]**

**§ 174-1. License required; exemptions.**

All peddlers and all other persons, whether principal or agent, without a permanent manufacturing plant, storeroom or warehouse, traveling from house to house or from place to place in the Borough of Port Carbon with goods, wares, merchandise or produce of any kind and selling in said Borough of Port Carbon, shall first procure a license to do so from the said Borough of Port Carbon; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall apply to farmers selling their own produce or to any sale of goods, wares or merchandise the proceeds whereof are to be applied to any charitable, religious or philanthropic purpose, nor to any disabled soldier who has procured a disabled soldier's license under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

**§ 174-2. Application for license.**

Application for such license shall be made to the Mayor of the Borough of Port Carbon upon suitable forms to be provided by the Borough of Port Carbon, setting forth under oath the name of the person, firm or corporation; the nature of the business to be conducted, including the kind of wares, merchandise, goods or produce to be sold; and the period of time for which the license is desired.

**§ 174-3. Investigation; denial or issuance of license.**

The Mayor of the Borough of Port Carbon shall investigate the facts set forth in said application, and no license shall be issued until such investigation is completed. If the Mayor finds that the facts set forth in said application are not as represented, the license shall not be issued. After the investigation by the Mayor, if the applicant or applicants have complied with all the terms and provisions of this chapter, he shall endorse his approval upon the application and shall issue the license upon the payment of the license fees hereinafter mentioned.

**§ 174-4. License fee. [Amended 4-8-2008 by Ord. No. 1-2008]**

At the time the Mayor issues the license, he shall collect from the applicant a license fee as set from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council for each day for which the license shall be issued.

**§ 174-5. Exhibition of license.**

Every licensee granted a license under the terms of this chapter shall exhibit the same upon request to any policeman of the Borough of Port Carbon or to any person or persons with whom such licensee desires to transact business.

**§ 174-6. Violations and penalties. [Amended 4-8-2008 by Ord. No. 1-2008]**

Any person or persons violating the provisions of this chapter shall be punishable as set

forth in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article I, General Penalty, of this Code.
