

ORDINANCE NO. 2010- 1

**BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON
TAX LEVY ORDINANCE**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF PORT CARBON, COUNTY OF SCHUYLKILL, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2011 AT 12.149 MILLS.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Port Carbon previously enacted a real estate tax rate at 12.149 Mills; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Port Carbon intends upon maintaining its current real estate tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Port Carbon is required to annually ordain its real estate tax rate under the Borough Code at 53 P.S. § 46310 following adoption of its annual budget;

WHEREAS, the Borough of Port Carbon, as part of its budget publication process, advertised its millage rate at 12.149, and said budget has been opened to public inspection;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon, County of Schuylkill, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that a tax be and the same is hereby levied and increased on all real property and occupations within the Borough of Port Carbon subject to taxation for the fiscal year 2011 as follows:

SECTION 1.

Tax rate for general purposes, the sum of 12.149 Mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.

The sum being summarized in tabular form as follows:

Tax Rate for General Purposes	12.149 Mills
TOTAL	12.149 Mills

SECTION 2. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable and if any clause, sentence, word, section, or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason, by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any portion of the ordinance other than said part or portion thereof.

SECTION 4. Any ordinances not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.


