

Chapter 29

FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIATION

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon 4-24-1933 as Ord. No. 119. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 29-1. Official recognition.

The Port Carbon Firemen's Relief Association of the Borough of Port Carbon, Pennsylvania, is hereby officially recognized by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon as an organization formed for the purpose of maintaining an association for beneficial and protective purposes to its members and their families in case of death, sickness, temporary or permanent disability or accident from the funds collected therein.

§ 29-2. Designation as association to receive funds.

The aforesaid Port Carbon Firemen's Relief Association of Port Carbon is hereby designated by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon as the proper association to receive such funds as are due and payable to the Borough treasury by the State of Pennsylvania from the two-percent tax on premiums from foreign fire insurance companies.

§ 29-3. Annual appropriation.

There is hereby annually appropriated from the Borough treasury all such sum or sums of money that may hereafter be paid to the aforesaid Borough treasury by the Treasurer of the State of Pennsylvania on account of taxes paid on premiums by foreign fire insurance companies in pursuance of an Act of Assembly in such case made and provided.
