

Chapter 77

AMUSEMENTS

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Port Carbon 6-3-1952 by Ord. No. 147. Amendments noted where applicable.]

§ 77-1. License required for circus or carnival.

Any, show, circus, carnival or other public amusement to be held in the outdoors of the Borough of Port Carbon shall first procure a license from the said Borough of Port Carbon.

§ 77-2. Application for license.

Application for such license shall be made to the Mayor of the Borough of Port Carbon upon suitable forms to be provided by the Borough of Port Carbon, setting forth under oath the name of the person, firm or corporation; the nature of the show, circus, carnival or other amusement to be held within the Borough of Port Carbon; and the period of time for which the license is desired.

§ 77-3. Investigation of applicant; issuance or denial of license.

The Mayor of the Borough of Port Carbon shall investigate the facts set forth in said application, and no license shall be issued until such investigation is completed. If the Mayor finds that the facts set forth in said application are not as represented, the license shall not be issued. After the investigation by the Mayor of the Borough of Port Carbon, if the applicant or applicants have complied with all the terms and provisions of this chapter, he shall endorse his approval upon the application and shall issue the license upon the payment of the license fee hereinafter mentioned.

§ 77-4. License fee. [Amended 4-8-2008 by Ord. No. 1-2008]

At the time the Mayor issues the license, he shall collect from the applicant for each day for which the license shall be issued a fee as set from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council.

§ 77-5. Violations and penalties. [Amended 4-8-2008 by Ord. No. 1-2008]

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be punishable as set forth in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article I, General Penalty, of this Code.
